**NEW DATA ON THE PALEARCTIC XANTHOLININI. 8°. NEW RECORDS AND ILLUSTRATIONS ON SOME SPECIES**

(Coleoptera: Staphylinidae)

247° CONTRIBUTION TO THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE STAPHYLINIDAE

**Abstract.** Some species of Xantholinini, from private collections and museums, are listed, especially from Gridelli's collection, preserved in the "Museo civico di Storia naturale" of Trieste. The following species seem to be new for the named countries (the records from Slovenia are doubtful because some territories, in the past, belonged to Italy): *Leptacinus intermedius* Donisthorpe, 1936 (Ukraine), *L. batychrus* (Gyllenhal, 1827) (Tajikistan), *L. simeki* Bordoni, 1975 (Tajikistan); *L. sulcifrons* (Stephens, 1833) (Tajikistan, Pakistan), *Gyrohypnus fracticornis* (Müller, 1776) (Algeria), *Gauropterus fulgidus* (Fabricius, 1776) (Israel), *G. notabilis* Kirshenblat, 1951 (Iran), *Xantholinus bordonii* Coiffait, 1970 (Italy: Alto Adige), *X. colasi* Jarrige, 1941 (Spain), *X. elegans* (Olivier, 1795) (Slovenia); *X. procerus* (Erichson, 1839) (Poland), *X. rufipennis* Erichson, 1839 (Italy: Tremiti Islands), *Megalinus flavocinctus* (Hochhuth, 1849) (Italy: Veneto), *M. pseudohesperius* (Reitter, 1908) (Malta), *Vulda mihoki* (Bernhauer, 1914) (Slovenia), *Hypnogyra angularis* (Ganglbauer, 1895) (Slovenia). The sexual characters of the following species are illustrated: *Stenistoderus subangulatus* (Reitter, 1908) and *Xantholinus translucidus* (Scriba, 1870).

**Riassunto.** Nuovi dati sugli Xantholinini paleartici. 8°. Nuove segnalazioni e illustrazioni di alcune specie (Coleoptera, Staphylinidae). 247° contributo alla conoscenza degli Staphylinidae. L'autore elenca specie di Xantholinini di collezioni private e museali ed in particolare della collezione Gridelli del Museo civico di Storia naturale di Trieste. Le seguenti specie sembrano nuove per le regioni citate (le citazioni relative alla Slovenia sono dubbie in quanto alcuni territori erano un tempo italiani): *Leptacinus intermedius* Donisthorpe, 1936 (Ucraina), *L. batychrus* (Gyllenhal, 1827) (Tagikistan), *L. simeki* Bordoni, 1975 (Tagikistan), *L. sulcifrons* (Stephens, 1833) (Tagikistan, Pakistan), *Gyrohypnus fracticornis* (Müller, 1776) (Algeria), *Gauropterus fulgidus* (Fabricius, 1776) (Israele), *G. notabilis* Kirshenblat, 1951 (Iran), *Xantholinus bordonii* Coiffait, 1970 (Italia: Alto Adige), *X. colasi* Jarrige, 1941 (Spagna), *X. elegans* (Olivier, 1795) (Slovenia), *X. rufipennis* Erichson, 1839 (Italia: Isole Tremiti), *X. procerus* (Erichson, 1839) (Polonia), *Megalinus flavocinctus* (Hochhuth, 1849) (Italia: Veneto), *M. pseudohesperius* (Reitter, 1908) (Malta), *Vulda mihoki* (Bernhauer, 1914) (Slovenia), *Hypnogyra angularis* (Ganglbauer, 1895) (Slovenia). Sono proposti i disegni dei caratteri sessuali delle seguenti specie: *Stenistoderus subangulatus* (Reitter, 1908) e *Xantholinus translucidus* (Scriba, 1870).

This list is based mainly on the specimens of the Gridelli's collection preserved in the "Museo civico di Storia naturale" of Trieste, and on several other collections. It is interesting to highlight that most of the records are collected by famous old collectors who have made the history of the Entomology in the early XX century. The purpose of this note is to improve the geonomical knowledge of the treated species and to pay tribute to Eduardo Gridelli who first studied the morphology of the Xantholinini and in particular the

aedeagus of some *Xantholinus* Dejean, 1821 and *Vulda* Jaquelin du Val, 1853 (GRIDELLI, 1947a, b, 1950). For the European distribution see SMETANA (2004); for the Italian geonemy see BORDONI (1982). The genera are listed in systematic order, while the species are listed in alphabetical order.


